

We are pleased to invite you to a special full day workshop for sonographers, in preparation for the introduction of Saving Babies' Lives Care Bundle v2 from April 2020.

This workshop follows on from a recent national survey which found significant shortfalls in training and workforce capacity needed to fulfil Saving Babies' Lives Care Bundle v2. It will include live demonstrations of the main Doppler flow parameters and standards for ultrasound biometry, and advice for further training. The new GAP algorithms will also be presented which can be used for phased implementation of the SBL CBv2 protocol according to readiness of the service.

- Live Doppler flow demonstrations: Umbilical, Uterine and Middle Cerebral Artery
- Ultrasound biometry: improving accuracy and quality assurance
